

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS: 10/12/15 Nehemiah

Read Nehemiah 2:11-3:3 (through 32 if you want to read all the names & situations)

1. What did Nehemiah do when he got to Jerusalem?
2. Why did he inspect the walls at night and not tell anyone what he was doing?
3. In vs 17 & 18, how did Nehemiah present the problem to the Jews? Did he accuse them?
4. How did they view Nehemiah? What was their response?
5. Do we have a realistic view of church & life? How does Jesus reveal the “broken walls” in your life?
6. Do we allow outsiders to speak truth to us? Is Jesus your Nehemiah?
7. What does it mean to speak the truth in love? Give an example.
8. Are you living with “crumbled walls”? What keeps us from fixing them?
9. Do you have a testimony of Jesus helping you fix part of your “walls”?
10. Are small groups helpful in repairing and rebuilding our lives? How?
11. Vs 19 – was everyone favorable towards the project? Why or why not?
12. Vs 20 – what was Nehemiah’s response?
13. Do you ever get opposition when God wants to repair a broken place in your life?

“He who began a good work in you will be faithful to complete it.”
14. What does that verse mean? Does this give you hope?
15. In Nehemiah Chapter 3, who did the rebuilding? Why did they repair by their homes or work places?
16. Do you have a calling to rebuild anything? Why isn’t your calling insignificant?
17. How is God rebuilding your life ... and this church?
18. Is it difficult to be willing? What steps should we take?
