## Nehemiah

*Read Nehemiah Chapter 4*

1. Who was opposing rebuilding the walls? Why?
2. What was Nehemiah's response? What did the people do?
3. What are you called to build or rebuild? How can God use you?
4. Is Jesus rebuilding your "walls"? Are there any enemies to this?
5. In vs 7-12, what was the response of those who were against rebuilding the walls?
6. Have you ever been an enemy to what God was doing? What happened?
7. How does the enemy twist the truth or the Word to create doubt and fear?
8. What was the Israelites response? How can we respond today?
9. How do we turn back the curses of our enemy?
10. Read Col. 3:23 – How are we supposed to work? How is your attitude ... is it "have to" or "get to"?
11. Do you recognize when the enemy stirs up trouble? How did Nehemiah and the Israelites continue the work even in the face of opposition?
12. Does God have something better for you in your life? Have you had trouble hearing "through" the enemies lies?
13. Do you take time to listen to God's voice? How can we have success and breakthrough in our lives?
14. When a weakness is exposed, what should we do?
15. Vs 16-23 - How did the Israelites obey God? How did they support each other during this rebuilding campaign?
16. How can God use us to help each other overcome obstacles and rebuild?
