

## HG: Questions for 4/27/15 week

1. Jim talked about a lamp broken by a child and the mother fixing it with gold paint, making it a focal point of conversation from that point on. When you think about the broken lamp being put back together and the cracks covered by gold paint so it transformed the lamp into a thing of beauty... how are our lives similar? What are the cracks? What does the gold represent?
2. When you go through trying times, do you feel alone? Is God with you? How do you know?
3. Read 1 Samuel 14:6-13... Does God respond to acts of faith and obedience? What happened in this Scripture?
4. Read Esther – Chapter 1 ... How was the stage set for God to bring His people into position?
5. What is the significance of God using an orphan girl in this event?
6. Why has God allowed you to be born “for such a time as this”?
7. Do you have a calling? Is there something God wants to do in and/or through your life?

8. If part of God’s nature is that He chooses to work through us, is God at work in the world today? How can He use you?
9. Do you have any (brief) testimonies of what God has done in your life?
