

Home Group Questions: Week of 6/29/15 – Joseph

“It’s not about how we start, it’s how we finish!” Genesis 37

1. Why were Joseph’s brothers jealous of him? What did they do to him?
2. Was it ok for them to do what they did? How did God turn it to good?
3. Have you ever blamed your current (or future) life on what happened in the past? How has God helped you overcome your situation(s)? Was it difficult?
4. Were Joseph’s dreams of his own making? How did he handle his gift?
5. Do you have a dream? Do you have a dream or vision for God’s Kingdom?

Genesis 39

6. How was Joseph tested in Potiphar’s household? What was the result? Was it a reward or consequence of someone’s sin?
7. Have you been in a situation that tested your integrity? Were you tempted to compromise and/or justify your response? Were you able to do what’s right?
8. What was Joseph’s attitude? Did he give in to anger and bitterness? How has your attitude been in these situations?
9. How was he faithful? Is it easy to fulfill God’s plan? Do you trust God?
10. Ephesians 5:1-2 - How are we supposed to live?
11. Genesis 40 – What happened in prison that showed God’s hand was still with Joseph? Did he get immediate relief?
12. Genesis 41 – How did God get Joseph out of prison? What happened to him?
13. Was Joseph’s suffering worth God’s eternal plan? Did Joseph think the cost was too high?
14. In Hebrews 12:14-15 - Do you have God’s perspective? Do you fear how God will use you?
15. How did God use what the enemy had schemed against Joseph to bring about good? Can He do that for you? Has He already done that in your life? (testimonies)
