Mark 8:1-21

1. Do you ever doubt what you see? Do signs and wonders increase your faith?
2. How did the disciples respond to Jesus' desire to feed the people? Were they viewing things through their physical eyes or their spiritual eyes?
3. What did Jesus have them do?
4. Have you had situations where things seemed overwhelming? What was your response? Have you seen God intervene in your life?
5. Why don't we sometimes have ears to hear and eyes to see?
6. How did Jesus' view of God as His Father in Heaven differ from the religious leaders of the day?
7. How many ways did Jesus demonstrate compassion for the people?
8. Psalm 34:10 – What lions have we faced? What is God's promise?
9. How have we as a church missed the needs of today's generation? Do we look like Pharisees to the world today? How?
10. Do we show our faith in God's grace in our lives? How?
11. Has God ever answered a need right after you prayed ... or even before you even prayed for it?
12. Why did the Pharisees ask for a sign? Why didn't Jesus do what they wanted?
13. How does the "yeast" of unbelief affect the church? How does a lack of faith affect our prayers? How can we combat it?
14. What stresses you out? Can God meet your needs? What if He meets them differently than what you expect?
