1. How did Jesus heal this blind man?
2. Why did Jesus pray a second time? Was it failure on Jesus part that he had to pray twice?
3. How many times have you prayed for something before God answered?
4. Are you satisfied with “seeing men like trees”? What does it mean to “press in”?
5. Why does God move instantly in some cases, while other times we have to persevere?
6. What is the difference between having a “knowledge of Jesus” and “knowing Jesus”?
7. Which is more satisfying... partial sight or full sight, like the blind man in the story?
8. Why do people sometimes settle for partial sight?
9. Why didn't Jesus want the man to go into the village?
10. Why did Jesus ask the disciples who people said he was?
11. Who had the right answer? Why did he tell them not to tell anyone?
12. Why did Jesus end up rebuking Peter? What had Jesus just got telling them?
13. Psalm 7:13-14 – Why did Jesus have to suffer and die?
14. What does it mean to take up your cross and follow him?
15. Can we follow Jesus without the cross? Can we find salvation without the cross?
16. Jesus took our place on the cross... how can we live for him? What is your relationship with Jesus?
