7. Why did Jesus teach about Anger? What can it lead to? What can we do when we’re angry?
8. Why would the Lord value reconciliation more than a sacrifice?
9. What is your offering to God today? Have you been in this position before?
10. How can we handle these situations in a Godly way?
11. How does Jesus define adultery? Why would this have been a different way of thinking?
12. Our society tells you to “enjoy the view”. Is this the same thing? Why could this lead to sin?
13. How did Jesus tell them to remove temptation? What can we do today?
14. How does God feel about divorce? Why did Jesus have to spell things out?
15. How important is a covenant of marriage to God? What can destroy a marriage? How can a marriage relationship be healed?
16. Are oaths good things or bad? Why is it better to simply answer “yes” or “no”?
17. Is following Jesus about “fairness”? Has the Lord changed the way you think about things? How?
