5. How should we use judgement to restore others? What is the proper setting for this type of conversation?
6. Why is love and compassion necessary when we hold someone accountable?
7. How is grace, mercy and forgiveness important?
8. How is our attitude so important in how we perceive others?
9. Do you judge yourself the same way you judge others? Is it important to do a self-check?
10. Which are we called to do... point out sin (within the Body) or walk through sin? What's the difference?
11. Do you like apologizing? How do you know when criticism has gone awry?

13. 1 Corinthians 5:12-13 - Do we judge Christians the same as non-Christians?
